The "Ramón y Cajal" Programme is run by the Ministry of Education and Science (*Ministerio de Educación y Ciencia* (MEC)) and supports the hiring of researchers for the Spanish Science and Technology System. The contacts provided through this programme are for PhD holders and are for a period of 5 years.

For 2008, MEC is offering 245 grants for R+D centres wishing to appoint doctors into their research teams.

Candidates for Ramón y Cajal researcher contracts should directly contact principal investigators at IRB Barcelona.

Juan de la Cierva Subprogramme 2008

Application deadline (18/03/2008)

The "Juan de la Cierva" Programme is run by the MEC and supports the hiring of young PhD holders by non-profit making R+D centres in the public and private sectors. The programme provides 3-year contracts. For 2008, MEC is offering 345 grants for R+D centres to contract doctors for their research teams.

Application process:

1. To apply to this call, IRB Barcelona will complete an electronic form provided by the ministry. For this purpose, candidate researchers, on previous agreement with the corresponding Principal Investigators, must first complete the electronic form provided for researchers, following the instructions outlined in the call.

To complete the documents required, the following should be attached following the models established by MEC:

- Curriculum Vitae of the candidate.
- Scientific and technical background of the research team over the last 5 years.
- Curriculum Vitae of the Principal Investigator.
- Report on the research activity to be undertaken by the candidate.

2. After submission of the incorporation agreement, this document should be printed and sent duly signed to the Human Resources Dept. **BEFORE 10/03/08**, accompanied by the remaining papers requested in the call.
